GENERAL NOTICE OF REGISTRABLE INTERESTS

Alfreton Town Council's Code of Conduct adopted on 11th September 2012

I, Councillor JANET MARY GYULA

a Member of Alfreton Town Council (the Council) give notice that

Either

I have no registrable interests which are required to be declared under the Council's Code of Conduct, and I have put 'none' where I have no such interests under any heading.

Or

I have set out below under the appropriate headings my interests, and those of my spouse/civil partner (or person with whom I am living as such) of which I am aware, which I am required to declare under the Council's Code of Conduct. These include any disclosable pecuniary interests under sections 29 to 31 of the Localism Act 2011 and The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012, and I have put 'none' where I have no such interests under any heading.

Note:

1. Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a 'Sensitive Interest' you need not include that interest provided you have consulted with the Monitoring Officer and he agrees that it need not be included. A 'Sensitive Interest' is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk that you or a person connected with you may be subjected to violence or intimidation.

2. Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change

3. This form gives general guidance, but is not comprehensive. The Town Council's Code of Conduct gives precise requirements. The Localism Act and the Regulations named above should be referred to where necessary. Continuation sheets should be used where needed and clearly marked.

3. Securities

You should detail any beneficial interest in securities of a body which has to your knowledge a place of business or land in the Town of Alfreton and either the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital, or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of any class of shares issued.

12. Compliance with the contract and consequence of non-compliance

I agree to keep a written record of my campaigning activities in any format demanded by my Chief Whip and to provide a copy of this record to the Group Chief Whip on a quarterly basis with my first report being provided for the quarter period ending 30 September 2013. I understand that the Group Chief Whip will maintain a record of the compliance of all Group members with this councillor contract and will publish the details of activities for each member to the Group and to the Local Campaigning Forum every six months. The Group Whip will also send a copy of my activities annually to my CLP and Branch in my electoral division. If I need additional support in order to comply with this contract I will discuss my requirements with the Group Chief Whip.

I recognise that details of my campaigning activities will be taken into account when deciding whether or not I should be admitted to the approved panel of candidates for the 2017 DCC election and that my failure to comply with this contract may result in my not becoming an approved Labour Party candidate for that election.

I also recognise that my failure to comply with this contract may prohibit me from standing for any position on DCC or any outside body that attracts a special responsibility allowance.

13. Appeals

In any case of dispute over my compliance with this contract I shall have a right of appeal to a panel comprising two members of the DCC Labour Group and one representative of the Local Government Forum, who is also an observer to this Group.
